

Mission Moment

Screening for health in Somalia

Samsam, a mother of five, lives in a community in Somalia where access to food is a consistent struggle and many people are malnourished. Samsam jumped at the opportunity to join a PWS&D-supported program to learn about nutrition for infants and young children. Through this program, she discovered a simple trick for determining whether a child or mother is malnourished: taking a measurement near the top of their arm. Now, by helping community members screen for malnutrition, Samsam is making sure that people in her village are receiving the care that they need. This program demonstrates the multiplying effect of enabling communities to help themselves. With 1,540 people trained on how to measure malnutrition in this way, over 15,000 children and 5,000 women have been screened so far. *PWS&D helps children and mothers embrace a more promising future*

Great NewsWe are in the final stage of making PraiseFM a reality as a full powered Christian radio station broadcasting on the FM Bandwidth.

As most of you know we have built the broadcasting studios, secured a full powered FM radio licence from the CRTC to cover the whole of the CBRM on 90.7. We have developed a new multi – media, interactive website, with downloadable apps for smart devices at <u>www.praisefmcb.com</u>

We have recruited a number of local Christian volunteers to host radio shows from 6.30am - 12midnight, and have been broadcasting a full schedule of music and programs for 4 years on the internet.

To date \$50,000 of the \$70,000 has been raised towards the goal of completing the Transmitter / Tower Site. We need your help in raising the final \$20,000 required. Every gift helps us to reach this goal.
