Mission Moment

Millions of people are in need of humanitarian assistance due to the Russian invasion of Ukraine.

Larysa, her husband and her daughter escaped Kharkiv after spending four nights in the basement of their home due to bombings in the city. "Everyone wanted to travel out of Kharkiv. There were many people at the train

station,” shared Larysa. The family found shelter in a refugee centre supported by the ACT Alliance. “We are happy to have a place to sleep and where it is warm. It is safe here. I am glad our children are alive.” Presbyterian World Service & Development is supporting Hungarian Interchurch Aid with an appeal issued by the ACT Alliance to provide emergency food assistance, essential non-food aid, health care and emotional support to refugees and internally displaced people.
